

Aerodrome not licensed for night flying. No Microlights permitted at aerodrome.

No helicopters unless for maintenance.

Strictly no Gyrocopters.

Pilots and passengers using aircraft parking Area C must use the pick-up point designated on the AD Chart.

No person is permitted to proceed south of the designated area at any time.

Arrivals: Rwy 07 joins from the west - report at Snetterton Heath;

Rwy 25 joins from the east - report at Tacolneston Mast.

Departures: Rwy 07 - Maintain runway heading until reaching 1500 ft agl;

Rwy 25 - Turn onto track 270° and maintain until reaching the railway

line South of Attleborough.

Circuits at 1000ft agl, LH on Rwy 07, RH on Rwy 25.

Overhead Joins are prohibited except for training approved by the aerodrome management.

Please avoid overflying the village of Old Buckenham (1 nm SSW of airfield) and the town of Attleborough (2nm NW of airfield).

ENSURE FAMILIAR WITH NOISE ABATEMENT, MAP ON WEBSITE. DOWNWIND LEG STRICTLY NORTH ABEAM ATTLEBOROUGH AND THE A11.

Warnings:

Beware of the gliding site at Tibenham 5nm to SE.

Tacolneston Radio mast, 888ft amsl, 3nm NE of the airfield.

Norwich Class 'D' Airspace up to FL50 to the north.

Vehicles may cross the runway at the intersection of the runway and perimeter road. Temporary straw stacks up to 40ft tall may be in place 250m from the thid of Rwy 25. Grass Rwy 07/25 operations must not be simultaneous with asphalt Rwy 07/25 operations.
