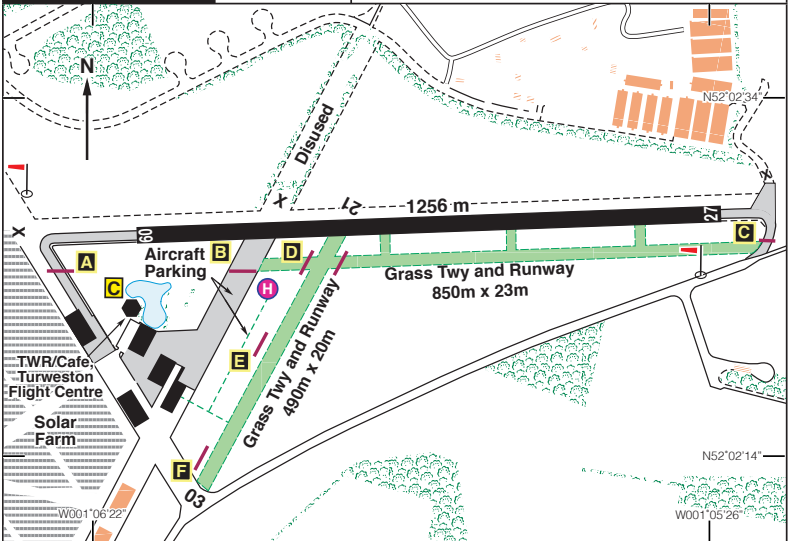

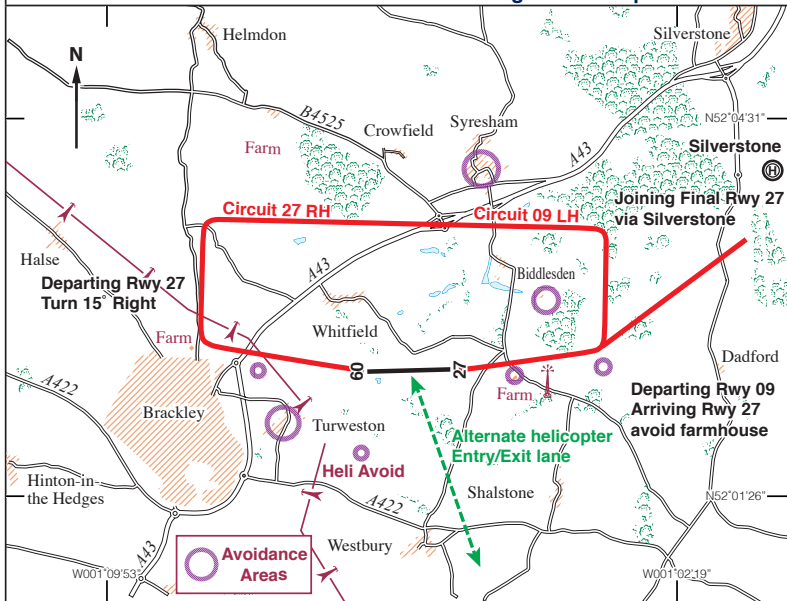

Noise Abatement Procedures - Fixed Wing and Helicopters



Noise Abatement Procedures

Turweston aerodrome is surrounded by noise sensitive areas and we would ask that all pilots familiarise themselves fully with the noise abatement procedures and follow them.

Departures

Runway 09: Turn left 10° at the end of the runway.

Maintain track 080° to pass North of Evershaw Farm and South of Whitfield Wood, avoiding the hamlets of Wood Green and Biddlesden before turning North (1.4 nm).

Runway 27: Turn right 15° at the end of the runway.

Maintain track 285° until passing the A43 and avoid the villages of Turweston (South) and Whitfield (North)

Arrivals

Runway 09: Fly final approach offset 15° to the North of the runway from the A43 and avoid the villages of Turweston and Whitfield.

Runway 27: On base leg keep East of Whitfield Wood.

Fly final approach offset 10° to the North of the centreline avoiding Evershaw Farm.
