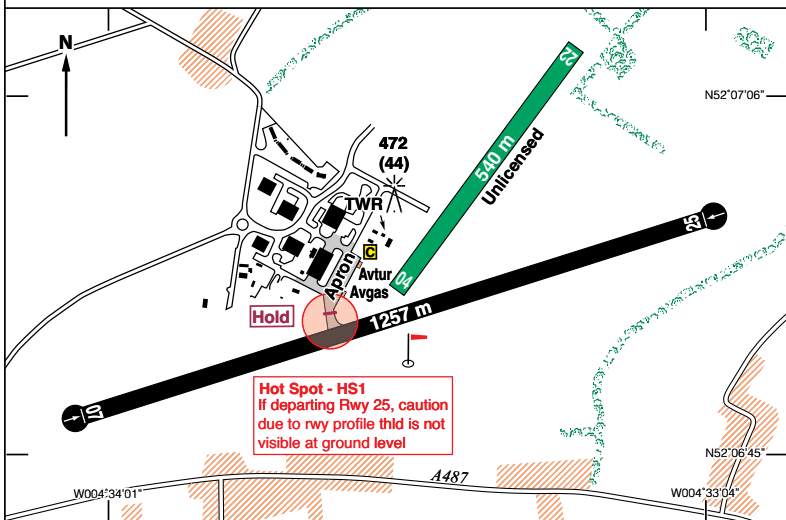

- When EGD 201H and EGD 202 are notified 'Active' inbound aircraft are advised at 25nm to call Aberporth Radar on 119-650 or when notified West Wales Radar on 127-090, otherwise call West Wales Information on 122-150.
- Unless otherwise notified by West Wales Information/Radio, a standard circuit joining procedure via overhead the AD is not permitted. The Southern lateral limit D201H is located approximately 1 nm North of the centreline of Rwy 07/25.

Remarks (continued):

When notified active, entry in to the circuit is to ensure that acft avoid entry into the danger area. The intended entry point into the circuit should be notified to West Wales Information/Radio.

Unmanned Aerial Vehicle (UAV) flights take place at the aerodrome.

Circuits at 1000 ft aal, LH on Rwys 22 and 25, RH on Rwys 04 and 07.

High visibility clothing when airside is strongly recommended.

Wheel equipped helicopters are to land and take-off on the runway in use and ground taxi to/from the apron.
