

Obtain ATC clearance from Cardiff Approach 5 mins before CTR boundary.

Circuits: Light Civil at 800 ft QFE, Jets 1300 ft QFE; Glide acft 1500 ft QFE.

Low level circuits 500 ft QFE. RH on 07, LH on 25.

Avoid overflying St. Athan village below 1500 ft or 1700 ft QNH.

Locally based light aircraft give very late final call. If circuit active with Military aircraft, civil aircraft can expect to fly military oval circuits.

Aircraft should request start clearance stating position on aerodrome.

ATC clearance issued prior to taxi clearance being issued.

Aircraft can expect to depart and arrive via one of the published VFR routes.

Caution: Wind shear on final approach to Rwy 25. Railway line crosses final approach to Rwy 07, 282 m from thld. Road controlled by ATC operated traffic lights, crosses the thld of runways 25 & 07.


## VFR Arrivals

Designator	Rwy	Route	Maximum Altitude
VFR East	07&25	From the North East route as directed by Cardiff Tower to hold East of Aberthaw Power Station and as directed by St Athan ATC	1500 ft
VFR South	07&25	Enter CAS from the South, remain West of the quarry and as dirceted by St Athan ATC.	1500 ft
VFR Nash Point	07&25	Enter CAS via Nash Point route Eastbound along the coast over water then as directed by St Athan ATC.	1500 ft
VFR North Arrival	07&25	Enter CAS towards the St Hilary VRP to orbit and remain North of the mast then as directed by Cardiff ATC.	1500 ft
VFR Nash South	07&25	Enter CAS via Nash South then as directed by St Athan ATC.	1500 ft
VFR Straight In	07&25	Enter CAS to position Straight in for the runway in use.	1500 ft

VFR East	07&25	Aircraft remain West of Aberthaw Power Station over water, clearance limit Abethaw Power Station then as directed by Cardiff ATC.	1500 ft

VFR Nash Point	07&25	Aircraft remain within the confines of the LFZ and leave CAS to the West towards Nash Point VRP remaining overland and South of Cardiff Rwy 12 final track.	1500 ft	
VFR Nash South	07	Right turn after St Athan village but within the confines of the LFZ, track 250° to exit CAS via Nash South.	1500 ft

## ST. ATHAN LFZ & VFR Arrivals/Departures



Aerodrome is within the Cardiff CTR. Acft are to call Cardiff APP 5 min before entry. Acft unable to contact Cardiff App are to contact St Athan tower and remain outside controlled airspace until they recive ATC clearance to enter. Cardiff QNH used for initial approach and radar patterns.
