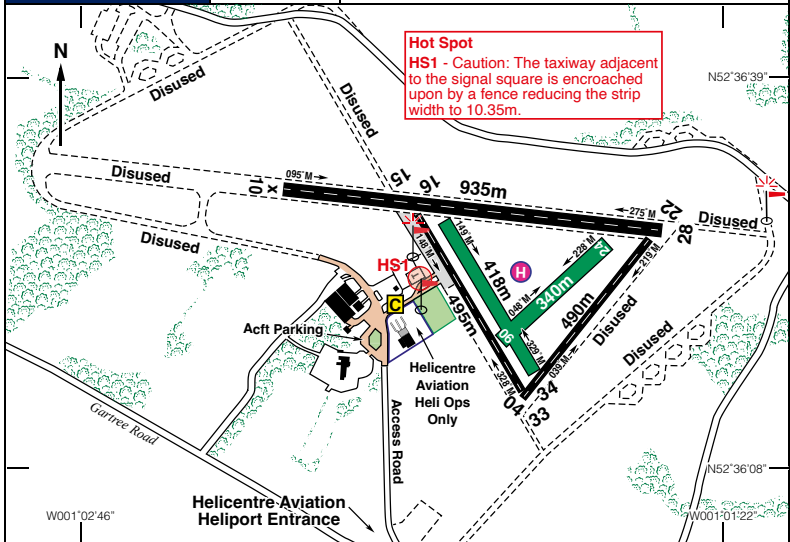

Non-radio aircraft must obtain prior clearance.

The standard overhead join is preferred for fixed wing aircraft.

Aircraft should not descend below 1200ft QFE on the deadside due to the helicopter circuit below 700ft QFE.

Fixed wing circuits at 1000ft QFE, RH on Rwys 04, 06, 15, 16 & 28.

LH on Rwys 10, 22, 24, 33 & 34.

Helicopter circuits at 700ft QFE, LH on Rwys 04, 06, 15, 16 and 28; RH on Rwys 10, 22, 24, 33 and 34. No overhead helicopter joins. Helicopters should join the helicopter circuit at 700ft QFE remaining clear of the fixed wing circuit.

Helicopter hover training takes place on the grass between the grass runways and on the grass runways when not in use.

Aircraft departing from Rwy 28 are to avoid local villages.

All helicopter arrivals are to contact Helicentre Aviation for booking in, handling and landing procedures.

All aircraft, including fixed wing requiring JET A1 fuel are to contact Helicentre Aviation to book in for refuelling.

Contact Helicentre Aviation for refuelling outside of operational hours.

Helicopter traffic are requested to follow marshalling signals when advised on Leicester Radio 122•130 A/G for parking and refuelling procedures.
